

Things You Can Fund

1. Curriculum that is secular in nature.
2. Tutors
3. Classes
4. Educators
5. School supplies & materials
6. Technology equipment (needs to be oked by Dan)
7. Safety Education Classes
8. CSAP testing)
9. Educational Trips that are approved by the Educational Trip Committee.
10. Internet with approval of RC

Things That Cannot be Funded

1. Weapons (including guns, knives, and paraphernalia used in relation to these items such as hunting licenses, scopes, targets, cleaning kits and ammunition)
2. Pets or livestock, animal food, veterinary visits, and animal handling / training equipment.
3. Items that will financially benefit the individual learner (i.e. rodeo entry fees, 4H registration fees)
4. Personal items that would normally be purchased by the family (i.e. shoes, gloves, coats. personal athletic equipment to be kept by the learner)
5. Services provided to a student by an immediate family member. Immediate family member means spouse, guardian, parent, step-parent, sibling and any person living within the same dwelling as the student.
6. Vacations and entertainment (i.e. admission into amusement parks or professional sports games)
7. Religious, partisan, sectarian, or denominational textbooks, curriculum, or instruction
8. Student fees related to participation in CHSAA sanctioned activities
9. Maintenance for items that are not Vision property, (i.e. piano tuning, computer repair, computer upgrade)
10. Mileage for Vision required activities, such as RC meetings, CSAP testing and graduation meetings.
11. Chemicals
12. Mentors
13. Fees for the Montrose Educational Coop
14. Montrose Educational Coop Educators who are not in the Vision Educator

15. Classes or activities in June.
16. Late fees or insurance

Restrictions

1. Sports passes & memberships can only total \$300 for the year (i.e. If you fund a \$150. rec. pass and you want to fund a ski pass later in the year, you can only fund \$150 of the ski pass to equal \$300 total for the year)
2. Can only fund 1 black ink cartridge & 1 color ink cartridge per semester per child
3. Annual passes only funded in Aug and Sept
4. The only receipts dated from previous school year we can fund are receipts for curriculum (April on)
5. Vision owned computers need to have repairs and software purchases done through Dan
6. Grocery receipts - items funded need to be required materials for a class or a line item for an educational trip.
7. Funds are learner specific - can't fund an item for a learner from sibling's funds
8. Only one parent is funded for entry fees when family feels an adult needs to be present
9. Any Item over \$100 must have an Educational Resource Agreement attached and signed by the consensus group with the funding.
- 10 Only two college classes per semester (11 credit hours) can be funded.
12. Funding guideline questions must be answered by the RC or the family and documented in the Curriculum Log.
13. Internet: family can do a PO for the installation fee but monthly bills will be reimbursement only for no more than the internet amount charged.

Part Time Learners (other than Kindergartner's)

The **only** items fundable for part time learners are outside classes and items required by those outside classes. If you are funding an item required by a class, documentation for that requirement must accompany the funding request. (i.e. dropping into Fat Cat Pottery is not considered a class)
