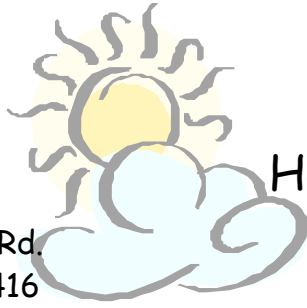

From the Director

June is here and with it comes the end of our school year. Our official school year runs from July 1st to June 30th. Families can begin and finish their year anywhere in between those two dates. I would like to encourage each of you to complete your school year prior to June 30th in order to provide your RC and the Administrative Staff time to get all of the required documents in order prior to the close date of June 30th. The building will be closed from June 17 - July 3. This provides time for us to finish up our tasks for the 2008-2009 school year and get ready for the 2009-2010 school year which begins in July.

Speaking of the 2009-2010 school year, you will receive a new handbook in July. It will include the new procedures adopted at the three procedure meetings, as well as, any improvements made to the online document templates. There are no newly proposed extreme differences for the documents; however, there are a few modifications that are being implemented based upon feedback from Families, Resource Consultants, and Highly Qualified Consultants. Another resource that will be available to current families, but not required for the current families, is an Enrollment Class. This class will be required for all new families. At this class, families will visit with the Director (program requirements), Technology Support Coordinator (computer issues and online documents), Learning Specialist (individual challenges for Learners and solutions), Highly Qualified Consultants (curriculum advice and structure), Assessment Coordinator (required and optional assessments), Guidance Specialist (future plans after high school and graduation), Resource Consultants (agreements with the program and RC), and Funding Administrators (items that can be funded and the process for funding) in order to gain the knowledge needed to navigate within this program successfully for each child. Anyone who is already in the program is also welcome to schedule a time to come and visit with any or all of these individuals in order to gain clarity or get a little more training in an area that still may be confusing to you. If you are planning on returning next year, talk with your Resource Consultant about your plans. If you would like a new Resource Consultant, please inform either the Assistant Director or Director of your needs.
